Appendix 1: Notes on points allocation

Points allocation (for mens/womens teams events) is based on:

- The number of points available in an event corresponds to the number of participants. The winner of a singles event earns the number of points equal to the number of participants.
- Assuming the same number of participants; singles and doubles offer the same total number of points.
- The team size was set at 3, to prevent states with more competitors receiving undue advantage due to a higher number of participants.
- For doubles pairings the points earned are divided equally between the two players.
- Doubles pairings across states subject to Deaf Tennis Australia board review
- Mixed not included towards Men's or Women's team results.
